A fundraiser dinner for the VFW Veterans & Military Support Program will take place at the **Sixth Annual O. Allen Beyer Memorial "German Knight"** on Saturday, January 25, 2020 from 7 to 11 PM at the Council Beer Garden, located at 150 Chestnut Street, Nutley, NJ.

There will be tasty German food such as kassler-rippchen (smoked pork chops), wiener schnitzel, frankfurters, knockwurst, bratwurst, sauerbraten, sauerkraut, red cabbage, German potato salad, potato pancakes, and, for those who have other tastes, we also offer a traditional pasta and 2 chicken choices. Three types of draught beer, wine, water, and soda are included.

The Band Horizon, a live 4-piece band, will perform, plus recorded music for your enjoyment! This year we have a guest speaker from our local Nutley Toastmasters International Club: Mr. Roy Jensen, a former United States Marine.

Who was O. Allen Beyer?

Otto Allen Beyer, who was a lifelong resident of Nutley, passed away on June 4, 2014. Mr. Beyer served proudly in the United States Army during the Korean War and was a member of the VFW Post #493. He was an active parishioner of St. Mary's Church, a Past Grand Knight of Council #2346, and during his single year as the GK, he achieved The Star Council Award, Activities Columbian Award and the Founders Award. Allen was the president of the Columbian Club at the time of his death. Allen served the council and the community for over 4 decades and hosted German Knight for over 25 years. The tradition continues in his name.

The Council has donated over \$12,500 to this worthy cause. All proceeds after expenses will be donated to the VFW Veterans & Military Support Program.
